Gibson County Native Bradley Owens Announces Campaign for Gibson County General Sessions Judge

(Gibson County, TN) – Local attorney, radio personality, community leader and Christian, Bradley Owens, has officially announced his intentions to run for Gibson County General Session Judge in 2022.

Born and raised in Gibson County, Owens has over 20 years of legal experience as an Attorney and Judge, having practiced civil and criminal law in all courts in Gibson County and the surrounding areas. Bradley is currently the managing member at Hardee, Martin & Owens PLC with offices in Trenton and Milan. Owens also served as Municipal Judge in Bradford for seven years and Medina for six years before stepping down to run successfully for the Gibson County Commission in 2018.

“I am so excited about the opportunity to serve our community as General Sessions Judge in a county that has been so good to me,” Owens said. “I realize that any campaign is difficult, but anything worth fighting for usually is. Trust is earned never given, so I plan to take our campaign across the county to listen and to call upon the people of Gibson County to join our effort. I am going to continue to work very hard to earn the people of Gibson County’s vote.”

Bradley is a 1994 Honors Graduate of Gibson County High School and a 1998 Graduate of Union University in Jackson where he earned a degree in Business Administration, Magna Cum Laude. Bradley graduated from Memphis Law School in 2001 serving on Law Review before returning home to Gibson County to practice law.

In 2009, Owens was part of an entrepreneurial group who brought back a radio station to Gibson County; Victory 93.7 FM. Bradley has served the Gibson County community as a radio personality and broadcaster for high school football and basketball games in all six high schools in Gibson County.

Owens has been involved in numerous philanthropic and community organizations including the Milan Recovery Court Advisory Board, Gibson County Recovery Court Evaluator, Carl Perkins Center for the Prevention of Child Abuse, Milan Lion’s Club, Humboldt Rotary Club, Humboldt Boys and Girls Club, and Milan Foundation. Bradley is a graduate of Gibson County Adult Leadership and WestStar. He has also assisted coaching children’s soccer, baseball, basketball and softball.

Bradley has previously been honored as Gibson County Young Professional of the Year, Mr. Gibson County by the Tri-City Reporter, Best of the Best Lawyer by the Milan Mirror Exchange and Tri-City Reporter, Union University Distinguished Business Award, and the Greater Gibson County Chamber Person of the Year.
