Objective:

Using the theme, develop a concept/product/idea/service that makes life better in Jackson, Tennessee.

Considerations:

- Use this competition to be creative/innovative with your ideas. There are only a few rules. Don't break the law, no plagiarism, and follow your university's code of conduct. Students will sign document about participation policy/agreement and a photo release.
- Incorporate the benefits of JEA's fiber network in your concept. (e.g., big data, video, internet technologies, etc.)
- Presentation format
 - o What is your concept?
 - Support your concept. (e.g., data, survey, discussion, observation, and etc.)
 - o Sell your concept. Clearly describe the specific benefits of your application. What makes this so important? What makes it different from others? How does it make life better? How does it help Jackson?
- Presentation should be no more than 5 minutes to allow time for 2 minutes maximum of questions from judges.
- Each team should plan to bring a laptop.
- Community experts cannot generate ideas for the team, but they can help advance the teams' ideas. Experts cannot serve as final round judges. No contact with community experts can occur outside of designated times.
- Each team is allowed ONE team advisor if they listed one at registration. This ONE advisor is allowed to be present with your team during the weekend. This advisor cannot generate ideas, but can advise and assist in advancing the teams' ideas. An advisor is definitely not required and many teams will choose to not have one. You are NOT at a disadvantage to go without an advisor.
