The Dodge Journey flees Northbound onto Campbell Street, while the occupants of the Nissan are seen chasing and still shooting at Jakobe Shaw as he fled down Redbud Street. Video surveillance on Redbud Street shows the occupants of the Nissan Sedan follow Jakobe Shaw, and stand over Jakobe and attempt to shoot him with an AR Pistol style weapon. The weapon does not fire, and Shaw runs away again. Other footage shows the occupant chase Shaw again, and more shots are fired. Jakobe Shaw stated that while fleeing on foot on Redbud Street, he was shot two more times, including in his back. During the shooting, PC Paladin's Repair at 20 Redbud Street was struck by gunfire while the owner of the business, Dawn Mooney, was inside. The business at 20 Redbud is also used as a residence.

Reckless Endangerment T.C.A. 39-13-103in the City of Jackson, Madison County, Tennessee on or about March 8th, 2025

Further, the affiant makes oath that the essential facts constituting said offense, the sources of the affiant's information, and the reason why his/her information is believable concerning said facts are as follows:

On March 8th, 2025 at approximately 2317 hours, Shotspotter alerted to multiple rounds being fired at 1400 North Highland, North Highland Express Gas Station in Jackson Madison County Tennessee. Upon Patrol Officers arrival to the area, witnesses advised that a Gray Nissan Sedan was involved in the shooting and fled North on Campbell Street. Patrol Officers gave chase as the vehicle fled to Victory Free Will Baptist Church at 3007 North Highland in North Jackson. Four armed occupants ran from the Gray Nissan on foot. Three of them, immediately identified as Kier Smith, Yusef Emery, and Destion Harrison, were apprehended by Patrol Officers at 149 and 102 Comanche Trail. Other patrol officers in the original area of the shooting located a victim on Redbud Street, identified as Jakobe Shaw. Shaw was suffering from multiple gunshot wounds, and was flown to Regional One in Memphis, TN. A short time later, a second victim, Courtney Boyland arrived at Jackson General ER with a gunshot wound to his left leg.

At this time, it was discovered that a second vehicle, a Blue Dodge Journey was involved in the shooting, and contact was made with the owner of the Journey, Lafrancese Johnson at Jackson General ER. She advised that she was inside of the Dodge Journey along with Courtney Boyland, Jakobe Shaw, and "Tay Tay", later identified as Cortavion Bufford when it was shot at by the occupants of a Gray Nissan Sedan at 1400 North Highland Avenue. Courtney Boyland confirmed that he was inside of the Dodge Journey when he was shot. The Dodge Journey was located at 51 Gilman Lane in the back parking lot of the apartment complex and towed to the Sally Port of the Police Station. Kier Smith 2nd, Destion Harrison, and Yusef Emery were all taken into custody.

Upon reviewing camera footage from 1400 North Highland, Paladin's PC Repair, as well as Pole Camera Footage, the Blue Dodge Journey is seen pulling behind the Nissan Sedan, and words are exchanged. A male subject exits the rear of the Dodge armed with a pistol, and shots are exchanged between the two parties.
