 - Circulation of over 420,000 for 23-24
 - Over 1000 programs in 23-24
 WE ARE GROWING AND RUNNING OUT OF SPACE!!!

Feasibility Study

- Conducted by Anders Dahlgren of Library Planning Associates (2020)
- Funded by Jackson-Madison Co. Library Foundation
- Very thorough
 - Examined data from years of usage
 - State Minimum Standards
 - Community Input from Stakeholder focus groups
 - Library Trends

Strategic Plan

- Developed from Results of Feasibility Study
- Calls for Main Library of no less than 65,186 sf (Currently 30,000)
- Calls for North Branch of 12,242 sq. ft. (Currently around 3500)
- Increased space for collaboration and use of technology
- More meeting rooms
- IMPORTANT: MAIN LIBRARY STAY WHERE IT IS
 In order for that to happen we needed more property.

Two Houses Purchased by City/County in the amount of \$250,000





City and County funded capital for Schematic Design - \$204,000

- Bids taken
- Interviews conducted
- Awarded to 4F Design and archimania

Almost \$500,000 already invested by City and County in the expansion!



- Estimated costs of design development is \$789,596
- Estimated costs of construction and renovation is \$32,228,390
- Important to remember this costs is split between City and County when the time comes
