Polly's Playground is the result of a community-driven effort spearheaded by the Leadership Jackson Class of 2024 Dragons Group, who selected the project as their group's initiative. Through their vision, dedication, and hands-on work, the team brought the playground to life with the support of a wide network of local partners and volunteers.

"This project has been a labor of love," said a spokesperson for the Dragons Group. "We wanted to create a safe, joyful, and healing space for teens who come to the Carl Perkins Center, and we are so grateful to all those who helped make it a reality."
