The undersigned affiant, after being duly sworn according to the law, states that

Teresa Larue

whose name is otherwise unknown to the affiant, committed the offense of

Second Degree Murder (TCA 38-13-210)

in the City of Jackson, Madison County, Tennessee on or about 6/18 20²⁵
Further, the affiant makes oath that the essential facts constituting said offense, the sources of the affiant's information, and the reason why his/her information is believable concerning said facts are as follows:

On 8-18-25 at approximately 2247 hours officers were dispatched to 1849-415 Hwy 45 Bypass in reference to a stabbing. Upon arrival officers observed [REDACTED] later identified as [REDACTED] sitting in a chair outside [REDACTED] bleeding from a stab wound to the left side of [REDACTED] chest. Officers began life saving measures and began to inquire about who stabbed [REDACTED] standing beside the officers stated [REDACTED] did. [REDACTED] was detained and was identified as Teresa Larue.

There were two witnesses, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] on scene who witnessed the incident. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were outside at the time of the incident. Inv. Cardona made the scene and took a statement from them. They both stated that they only knew of them by passing and did not know the victim or suspect's names. They stated that they saw the two were arguing and [REDACTED] was trying to take a chair from [REDACTED]. Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stated that the [REDACTED] was hitting the male and he was trying to de-escalate by telling [REDACTED] to go lay down. They stated that they both went inside the apartment and moments later the [REDACTED] came out saying "call the police [REDACTED] stabbed me". [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] still had the knife and when [REDACTED] started calling the police [REDACTED] threw the knife over the balcony.

The knife was recovered at the scene, photographed and tagged into evidence at JPD.
The victim [REDACTED] was transported to Jackson Madison County General Hospital but was later pronounced deceased at approximately 0003 hours of 8-19-25.
