


OFFICIAL VERSION:

DEFENDANT WAS INDICTED BY A MADISON COUNTY GRAND JURY FOR AGGRAVATED ROBBERY ON 4/28/14. THIS ALONG WITH ANOTHER CHARGE OF AGGRAVATED ROBBERY AND AGGRAVATED KIDNAPPING WERE TRANSFERRED FROM JUVENILE COURT ON/ABOUT 10/9/13. THE SECOND CASE WAS A "NO TRUE BILL" FOR BOTH COUNTS ON 4/28/14. DEFENDANT REQUESTED A JURY TRIAL AND THE TRIAL WAS HELD ON 8/27/14. AFTER A FINDING OF GUILT, THE JURY IMPOSED A FINE OF \$4,444.44. SENTENCING IS SET FOR 9/26/14 AT 9:30.

THE POLICE OFFENSE REPORT BY OFFICER J. KING RELATES THAT ON 7/31/13 AT ABOUT 0035 HOURS, OFFICER J. MULLINS AND OFFICER J. VINSON WERE NOTIFIED BY COUNTER CLERK, [REDACTED] AT CIRCLE K LOCATED ON NORTH HIGHLAND OF AN AGGRAVATED ROBBERY. IT HAD JUST OCCURRED AT THAT LOCATION. A DESCRIPTION OF THE PERPETRATOR WAS SENT OUT TO ALL AVAILABLE UNITS. THE AREA WAS SEARCHED FOR ABOUT 20 MINUTES BY ALL NORTH DISTRICT OFFICERS BUT THEY WERE UNABLE TO LOCATE THE SUSPECT.

UPON RETURNING TO THE STORE AND TALKING TO MS. [REDACTED], SHE STATED THAT THE SUSPECT WAS A WHITE MALE MID 20'S TO EARLY 30'S BETWEEN 5'8'' TO 6' WEARING DARK PANTS, A DARK SHIRT WITH A PRINTED DESIGN ON IT AND A DARK BALL CAP. HE CARRIED AN OLDER REVOLVER HANDGUN. THE SUSPECT TOOK \$45-\$46 IN CASH. A FINGERPRINT WAS LIFTED OFF OF THE CASH REGISTER WHERE THE SUSPECT HAD TOUCHED THE CASH DRAWER. SURVEILLANCE VIDEO FOOTAGE FROM THE STORE SHOWED THE SUSPECT ENTER THROUGH THE FRONT ENTRANCE AT APPROXIMATELY 0032 HOURS WALKING AROUND INSIDE FOR ABOUT 2 MINUTES, WAITING FOR CUSTOMERS TO EXIT AND THEN AT APPROXIMATELY 0034 HOURS, PRODUCING A HANDGUN AND ROBBING THE CLERK OF THE CASH IN THE CASH DRAWER. HE THEN EXITED THE STORE FLEEING PAST OFFICER MULLINS AND OFFICER KING. THE OFFICERS HAD JUST PULLED INTO THE STORE AND DID NOT KNOW THAT THE BUSINESS HAD BEEN ROBBED. THEY OBSERVED THE SUSPECT RUNNING IN AN EASTWARD DIRECTION ON EAST UNIVERSITY PARKWAY.

MS. [REDACTED] STATED TO OFFICERS THAT THE DEFENDANT CAME INTO THE STORE AND WENT UP AND DOWN EVERY ISLE. SHE THOUGHT HE WAS GOING TO STEAL SOMETHING. HE STOOD BY THE HOT FOOD AND TOLD HER HE HAD THE "MUNCHIES". THEN HE CAME TOWARD HER WITH A GUN AND TOLD HER "I AIN'T FU**IN PLAYING, GIVE ME THE MONEY." SHE OPENED THE REGISTER AND STEPPED BACK. THE SUSPECT WENT TO THE REGISTER AND GOT THE MONEY. HE EVEN LIFTED THE DRAWER AND LOOKED UNDERNEATH. HE SAID "YA'LL TRIPPIN" AND WAS VISIBLY UPSET THERE WASN'T MUCH IN THERE. HE SAID IT ABOUT 3 TIMES ON HIS WAY OUT.

DEFENDANT WAS ON THE RUN UNTIL HE WAS ARRESTED ON/ABOUT 8/21/13 IN DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA.

COMMENTS:

SINCE DEFENDANT WAS BOUND OVER FROM JUVENILE COURT, HE HAS NO ADULT RECORD. HE DOES HAVE QUITE A LENGTHY RECORD FROM MADISON COUNTY JUVENILE COURT. THAT RECORD IS AS FOLLOWS:

03/12/13- AT APPROXIMATELY 0400 HOURS, JPD WAS IN THE AREA OF MCO ROAD AND SMITHFIELD DRIVE REGARDING A POSSIBLE VEHICLE BURGLARY. DEFENDANT AND AN UNKNOWN MALE WERE ENCOUNTERED. OFFICERS ATTEMPTED TO PLACE BOTH SUBJECTS IN CUSTODY WHEN THEY BOTH FLED ON FOOT. AUSTIN RAN INTO THE WOODS AND WAS LATER CAUGHT. HE WAS CHARGED WITH RESISTING STOP, HALT AND FRISK.

03/31/13- THE MANAGER OF CATFISH CABIN ON SOUTH HIGHLAND IN JACKSON TALKED WITH DEPUTY RUSHING REGARDING SOMEONE SMOKING MARIJUANA ON THE RESTAURANT'S PREMISES. DEPUTY RUSHING BEGAN TO PAT AUSTIN DOWN AND HE OBSERVED A BAGGY OF A GREEN LEAFY SUBSTANCE RIGHT NEXT TO WHERE AUSTIN WAS STANDING. THE DEPUTY TRIED TO CUFF AUSTIN BUT HE FLED AND WAS LATER FOUND IN A DUMPSTER BEHIND A NEARBY VERIZON STORE. DEPUTY RUSHING TOOK CUSTODY OF THE BAGGY AND THE SHOES AUSTIN DROPPED AND FOUND A DIGITAL SCALE WITH GREEN RESIDUE ON IT. WHEN AUSTIN WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY, HE HAD \$400 CASH ON HIS PERSON. HE WAS TRANSPORTED AND CHARGED WITH POSSESSION WITH INTENT AND RESISTING ARREST.

07/16/12- DEFENDANT WAS CHARGED WITH THEFT OF PROPERTY AND VANDALISM OVER \$500 IN THAT ON 7/16/12, JPD OFFICER KING RESPONDED TO A THEFT REPORT AT KROGER'S AT UNIVERSITY PARKWAY IN JACKSON. KROGER EMPLOYEE, JONATHAN TRAVIS REPORTED THAT A MALE SUBJECT DRESSED IN BLACK ENTERED THE STORE AT 11:45 P.M., BROKE INTO THE CASH BOX AT REGISTER #5 AND FLED THE STORE. STORE MANAGER FRANK KEE DETERMINED THE BOX CONTAINED \$300 AND THAT THE BOX WAS DESTROYED. KEE IDENTIFIED EMPLOYEE AUSTIN DRUMMOND AS THE BAGGER AT REGISTER #5 IN THE VIDEO. DRUMMOND IS PRESENT WHEN THE CASHIER DROPS A CASH ENVELOPE IN THE BOX. HE IS WEARING A GRAY SHIRT, BLACK BRACELET ON HIS LEFT WRIST AND DISTINCTIVE ATHLETIC SHOES AS IN THE THEFT VIDEO.

ON 08/20/12, AUSTIN DID ASSAULT HIS YOUNGER BROTHER, [REDACTED], BY CHOKING HIM. AUSTIN THEN LEFT THE RESIDENCE PRIOR TO JPD ARRIVING. HE WAS LOCATED AT AROUND 1830 HOURS, WALKING ON NORTH HIGHLAND NEAR NORTH SIDE HIGH SCHOOL. WHEN OFFICER CHILCOTE ATTEMPTED TO TAKE HIM INTO CUSTODY, AUSTIN JERKED HIS ARM AWAY AND BEGAN RUNNING. HE WAS LATER LOCATED IN A STORAGE BUILDING ON COMMANCHE TRAIL. HE ENTERED THE

BUILDING WITHOUT PERMISSION OF THE OWNERS. HE WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY AND TRANSPORTED TO JDC.

ON 06/06/13, JUDGE CHRISTY LITTLE COMMITTED DEFENDANT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN'S SERVICES AFTER HEARING THE ABOVE MATTERS, INDICATING THAT DEFENDANT WAS DELINQUENT AND ALL REASONABLE EFFORTS HAVE BEEN MADE AND SERVICES RENDERED TO PREVENT/ELIMINATE THE REMOVAL OF SAID CHILD FROM HIS HOME, INCLUDING OUT-PATIENT COUNSELING AND PLACEMENT AT 3 SEPARATE FACILITIES (RIVER QUEST, LAKESIDE AND COMPASS ON 2 SEPARATE OCCASIONS).

ON 2/16/12 AT APPROXIMATELY 1730 HOURS, OFFICERS WERE DISPATCHED TO 177 REYNOLDS DRIVE IN REFERENCE TO A RUNAWAY REPORT. UPON ARRIVAL, OFFICERS MADE CONTACT WITH MR. GREGORY DRUMMOND WHO STATED THAT HIS SON AUSTIN CUT THE SCREEN OFF THE BATHROOM WINDOW AND LEFT THE RESIDENCE. AUSTIN RETURNED BACK TO THE RESIDENCE AND WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY FOR DOMESTIC VANDALISM. SEARCH INCIDENT TO ARREST, OFFICERS OBSERVED A SILVER GRINDER, USED FOR GRINDING MARIJUANA IN THE LEFT POCKET OF THE JACKET. AUSTIN WAS CHARGED WITH DOMESTIC VANDALISM AND POSSESSION OF DRUG PARAPHERNALIA AND TRANSPORTED TO JDC.

ON 3/1/12, A PETITION WAS SIGNED BY ROOSEVELT WASHINGTON, MADISON COUNTY JUVENILE COURT OFFICER, CHARGING THAT DEFENDANT WAS DELINQUENT AND IN NEED OF TREATMENT. HE WAS IN VIOLATION OF A VALID COURT ORDER: 2/8/12 HOUSE ARREST, ANKLE MONITOR VIOLATIONS. THE MONITORING SYSTEM REPORTED MULTIPLE VIOLATIONS OF AUSTIN LEAVING HIS PERMITTED ZONE. THE MONITORING SYSTEM AND AUSTIN'S MOTHER REPORTED THAT AUSTIN LEFT HOME AND DID NOT RETURN UNTIL THE NEXT DAY. HIS MOTHER FURTHER REPORTED THAT AUSTIN STATED THAT NOTHING CAN HAPPEN TO HIM. THE PARENTS WERE ORDERED TO PAY COURT COST AND HE WAS SENT TO YOUTH CHALLENGE AND WAS THERE AS OF 3/5/12. HE WAS FOUND GUILTY OF VIOLATION OF A VALID COURT ORDER. HE WAS 15 AT THE TIME.

ON 2/6/11 DEFENDANT AND ANOTHER SUBJECT WERE OBSERVED HITTING THE WINDOW OF THE CONCESSION STAND AT NORTH SIDE HIGH SCHOOL. THE OBSERVER STATED THAT HE PHONED POLICE AND WAITED. ANOTHER PERSON WITH THE CALLER SAW THE SUSPECTS ON THE ROOF OF THE SCHOOL. OFFICER ARRIVED AND CONFRONTED THE SUSPECTS WHO FLED ON FOOT. AFTER A CHASE THE TWO WERE CAPTURED. AUSTIN WAS CHARGE WITH CRIMINAL ATTEMPT TO

COMMIT BURGLARY AND EVADING ARREST. THIS CASE WAS DISPOSED ON 3/23/11 BY JUDGE CHRISTY LITTLE. DEFENDANT ENTERED A PLEA OF GUILTY AND WAS ORDERED TO DO 24 HOURS OF COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS. HIS PARENTS WERE TO PAY COURT COST OF \$72.00. HE DID COMPLETE HIS PUBLIC SERVICE WORK SUCCESSFULLY. HE WAS 14 AT THE TIME.

ON 10/17/09, DEFENDANT SHOPLIFTED SOME AXE DEODORANT, AXE HAIR SCRUB AND A LASER LIGHT (WHICH COULD NOT BE RETURNED, VALUED AT \$5.99) FROM WALGREEN'S ON NORTH HIGHLAND. HE TOOK THE ITEMS IN A RESTROOM AND CONCEALED THEM IN A BOOK BAG. WHEN CONFRONTED BY THE STORE MANAGER, HE CONTINUED TO WALK EAST ON UNIVERSITY PARKWAY WHERE HE WAS STOPPED BY A POLICE OFFICER. HE SURRENDERED THE ITEMS TO THE OFFICER.

THE STORE MANAGER REQUESTED \$5.99 IN RESTITUTION. THE COURT ALLOWED AUSTIN TO BE PLACED WITH A CITY/COUNTY AGENCY AND THIS WAS SUCCESSFUL. HIS RECORD WAS EXPUNGED/DISMISSED.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

DEFENDANT WAS REPORTED TO HAVE FREQUENT RUNAWAY BEHAVIOR. HE WAS SAID TO SNEAK OUT THE HOUSE AT NIGHT. HE ABSCONDED FROM THE MADISON COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT ON 6/13/13 AND WAS SAID TO BE CURRENTLY ON "RUNAWAY STATUS" ON 7/10/13 AS PER THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN'S SERVICES FAMILY PERMANENCY PLAN. THE PLAN ALSO INDICATED THAT DEFENDANT CHOSE COUNTERPARTS/FRIENDS WITH A DELINQUENT HISTORY. HE WAS DISCHARGED FROM THE COMPASS INTERVENTION CENTER ON 6/3/13. HE WAS REPORTED TO HAVE VERBALIZED THE DESIRE TO DISRUPT HIMSELF FROM TREATMENT WHILE THERE AND HAS PRESENTED WITH INCREASED DEFIANCE AND ASSAULTIVE BEHAVIORS TOWARD HIS PEERS IN AN EFFORT TO DISRUPT HIS TREATMENT. AN INTAKE APPOINTMENT WAS MADE AFTER HIS RELEASE IN ORDER FOR HIM TO CONTINUE OUT PATIENT SERVICES WITH PATHWAYS.

THIS OFFICER WAS UNABLE TO FIND ANY INFORMATION INDICATING WHEN AUSTIN WAS RETURNED FROM "RUNAWAY STATUS".

THROUGHOUT DEFENDANT'S JUVENILE APPEARANCES IN COURT AND PARTICIPATION IN TREATMENT PROGRAMS, HIS PARENTS WERE REPORTED TO BE INVOLVED AND COOPERATIVE.

A CRIMINAL HISTORY SEARCH SHOWED NO ADDITIONAL CHARGES. DEFENDANT DOES NOT HAVE A TENNESSEE DRIVER'S LICENSE.

STG AFFILIATION:

NO INFORMATION WAS FOUND INDICATING SUCH BY THIS OFFICER.

COMMENTS:

DEFENDANT REPORTED THAT HE WAS "KICKED OUT" OF NORTH SIDE HIGH SCHOOL IN NOVEMBER 2011. HE SAID HE COMPLETED THE 10TH GRADE. A DCS REPORT SHOWS THAT DEFENDANT WAS IN THE 11TH GRADE AT NSHS. THE REPORT ALSO SHOWS THAT DEFENDANT HAS NEVER HAD AN IEP (INDIVIDUAL EDUCATION PLAN) AND HAS NO EDUCATIONAL DISABILITY. AN EVALUATION INCLUDED IN DEFENDANT'S JUVENILE RECORDS SHOW THAT HE STATED THAT DURING THE SECOND HALF OF HIS FRESHMAN YEAR, HE BEGAN SKIPPING SCHOOL. HE STATED THAT HE WAS SKIPPING SCHOOL TO SMOKE MARIJUANA AND PRIOR TO SMOKING MARIJUANA, HIS GRADES WERE GOOD. HE SAID BEFORE HE STARTED USING DRUGS HE GOT ALONG WELL WITH BOTH TEACHERS AND HIS PEERS. HE SAID HIS FAVORITE SUBJECTS WERE SCIENCE, MATH AND HISTORY.

APPARENTLY SOMETIME AFTER HIS BEING EXPELLED FROM NORTH SIDE, HE STARTED GOING TO GATEWAY CHRISTIAN SCHOOL WHERE HE WAS IN THE 11TH GRADE. HE WAS REPORTED TO BE MAKING A'S AND B'S.

HE DID NOT PARTICIPATE IN ANY SPORTS OR ACTIVITIES IN THE COMMUNITY.

DEFENDANT ADMITS TO A PROBLEM WITH ALCOHOL AND DRUGS. HE REPORTS RECEIVING COUNSELING/TREATMENT AT BOTH RIVERQUEST AND COMPASS. HE STATED IN HIS QUESTIONNAIRE AND THIS WAS VERIFIED BY JUVENILE COURT RECORDS THAT HIS DRUGS OF CHOICE ARE MARIJUANA AND XANAX. HE SAID HE WAS USING MARIJUANA DAILY AND XANAX WEEKLY. ONE OR MORE OF HIS JUVENILE OFFENSES INVOLVED THE USE OF DRUGS.

MADISON COUNTY JUVENILE COURT RECORDS SHOW THAT WHILE DEFENDANT WAS BEING HELD IN THE DETENTION CENTER ON 3/12/13 AND 3/31/13, HE TESTED POSITIVE FOR MARIJUANA. ON 4/1/13 THROUGH 4/3/13, AUSTIN MADE SEVERAL ATTEMPTS TO HARM HIMSELF BY USING A BLANKET TO CHOKE HIMSELF UNTIL HE PASSED OUT. HE BIT INTO A PEANUT BUTTER CRACKER KNOWING THAT HE WAS ALLERGIC TO PEANUT BUTTER. HE TOLD EMPLOYEES IN DETENTION THAT HE WAS ABOUT TO DIE. HE TRIED TO DROWN HIMSELF IN THE TOILET. HE TRIED TO CUT HIS WRISTS BY USING THE ROUGH EDGES ON THE WALL. HE TOOK A BLANKET AND WRAPPED IT AROUND HIS HAND AND BEGAN HITTING IT AGAINST THE WALL. YOUTH VILLAGES (CRISIS) WAS CALLED WHEN HE TRIED TO CHOKE HIMSELF. AUSTIN WAS ASSESSED BUT CRISIS SAW NO NEED AT THAT TIME FOR INTERVENTION. HE WAS ASKED BY A COUNSELOR WHY HE WISHED TO HARM HIMSELF AND HE REPLIED THAT IT WAS BECAUSE HE DID NOT WANT TO BE HELD AT THE DETENTION CENTER.

IN SEPTEMBER, AUSTIN WAS EVALUATED AT PATHWAYS. HE WAS FOUND TO BE COMPETENT TO STAND TRIAL AND WAS DETERMINED TO HAVE THE ABILITY TO CONSULT WITH HIS ATTORNEY WITH A REASONABLE DEGREE OF UNDERSTANDING.
