On February 11, 2026, at about 1746 hours, Bolivar Police were dispatched to [REDACTED] Taylor Cove in Bolivar for several shots-fired calls through dispatch. Officers arrived on scene and observed two subjects suffering from gunshot wounds. The two victims were identified as Mr. Kejaun Wilkes and Mr. Jorvontai Polk. Mr. Polk had been shot in the right side of his chest under his arm and right bicep. Medical treatment was given to Mr. Polk by members of the Bolivar Police Department until EMS arrived on scene. Mr. Wilkes was suffering from a gunshot wound to the arm and was treated as well until EMS arrived on scene. The Bolivar Police Department Criminal Investigators made the scene and began to process the scene. While this was done, Lt. Wilkerson made contact with the persons who lived at [REDACTED]. Lt. Wilkerson spoke to Mrs. Michelle McNeal, who advised to him that her house was hit during the exchange of gunfire. The residence was found to have been hit in the front corner on the east side. There were two holes in the wall. These bullets went through the wall and into the house. Mrs. McNeal advised that she had been sitting in her recliner, and the bullet came through the wall and then struck her laptop, which was in her lap at the time. This bullet went through the laptop and landed in the hall where the bullet was located. In this same room where the bullet entered, there was a small child, (LW), who was playing between the wall and the laptop.

While there in the house of [REDACTED], I spoke to Mr. Leon McNeal. He advised that he was outside, at his carport when the shots rang out. Mr. McNeal then proceeded to observe Mr. Polk laying on the ground and yelling for his mother. There was another male who was shooting back from the fence/driveway area and at this point Mr. McNeal got down until the shots stopped.

Bolivar Police Department and other officers combed the scene for evidence and found 9mm shell casings throughout the backyard and carport area. Investigators also recovered 40mm shell casings near the red Mercedes in the front yard. A search warrant was obtained through the Bolivar Criminal Investigations Division, and a 40-caliber handgun was recovered from the kitchen drawer, believed to have been utilized by Kejuan Wilkes. Your affiant was able to watch Sky Cop camera footage and observed a black Nissan Altima ([REDACTED]) in the immediate area of the shooting. The black Nissan Altima came into the city limits of Bolivar before the shooting following a red Mercedes ([REDACTED]) the red Mercedes was on the scene of the shooting and belongs to Kejuan Wilkes. The Nissan Altima nearly drives off the road at one point while passing Taylor Cove. The Black Nissan Altima exits Thomas Cove a short time later, which is located directly behind the scene of the shooting. The Nissan Altima then turns onto Lee Street, during the time frame of the shooting the Black Nissan Altima never exits Lee Street until
