

just a few minutes after the shooting at approximately 1748 hours. The vehicle is then observed leaving the City of Bolivar a short time later and traveling toward Jackson, Tennessee. Contact was made with the Jackson Police Department and with the utilization of Flock Camera Systems, Jackson Police Department was able to initiate a traffic stop on the vehicle for a traffic violation. The driver of the vehicle was identified as Jacquarius Dance. Mr. Dance was placed on an investigative hold by the Jackson Police Department. A search warrant was obtained for the vehicle, and investigators observed one spent 9mm shell casing inside the vehicle. The shell casing matched the 9mm casing which were under the carport and in the backyard of [REDACTED] Taylor Cove. Investigators were able to determine the 9mm shell casings were fired at the victims from the backyard and carport of [REDACTED] Taylor Cove, while the victims were in the driveway of [REDACTED] Taylor Cove. Investigators also interviewed Mr. Dance on 2/12/26. Mr. Dance was mirandized and gave statements to investigators that he was operating the Black Nissan Altima and was behind the red Mercedes which was being operated by Victim Kejuan Wilkes. Mr. Dance also admitted to driving near the scene of the shooting before and after, and then driving to Jackson. Based on the above facts, Mr. Dance intentionally and with premeditation attempted to cause the death of Jorvontai Polk and Kejuan Wilkes. Mr. Dance will also be charged with three counts of Aggravated Assault in relation to the three subjects located directly across the street at [REDACTED] Taylor Cove being in fear for their life of serious bodily injury or death and the use of a deadly weapon being involved.
